


Figure 1. Prof. Dr. Hassan Farsam



Prof. Dr. Hassan Farsam was a prominent member of the Iranian Academy of Medical Sciences as well as America Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists (AAPS), Society for Medicinal Plant Research, WHO temporary advisor in traditional medicine & medicinal plants and member of New York Academy of Science. At least two generations of many of current faculty members in Iranian schools of pharmacies were his students. He was one of the most popular and respected professors of pharmacy in Iran.
