Ten Years with the Journal of Research on History of Medicine (RHM)

Abstract

The journal of research on history of medicine (RHM) starts to be published from Feb. 2012. It passed its first decade of life by publishing current issue. By analyzing these 10 volumes, it shows that there are 284 articles that are written by 342 authors from 18 countries. These authors are affiliated to 90 institutions, that Shiraz University of medical sciences has the most contribution among them. In addition, the share of Iranian authors is more than other countries significantly. The journal is indexed in 14 indexing and abstracting databases. It needs to set a program for improving the quality of international cooperation, indexing of the journal and published papers for next decade.

Introduction

Journal of Research on History of Medicine (RHM) has started to be published at February 2012 and we are celebrating 10th year's birthday of it by publishing 2021 November issue (Figure 1). This journal is published by Research Office for the History of Persian Medicine at Shiraz University of Medical sciences. We has started to publish this journal aiming to find "a way to introduce the science tradition and medical scientific methods" throughout the history and "to help the medicine, we are on our way to examine and analyze its history". (Mehdizadeh, 2012, pp. 1-2) The office of journal and Research Office for the History of Persian Medicine is located in historical 200 years old building, namely Behbudistan Namazi (Figure 2). Haj Mohammad Hassan Namazi dedicated this building as endowment to care patients in 1925 (Figure 3). (Nadim, and Adabinia, 2020, pp. 239-244)

Now, after 10 years publishing the journal of research on history of medicine continuously, in this paper the analysis of the content of the journal is presented. It helps us to find the status of the journal and try to improve it during its 2nd decade of publishing.

Editorial of the journal

The editorial team of research on history of medicine has minority change during these 10 years. In advance, Dr. Gholamreza Hatam, Dr. Alireza Mehdizadeh, and Dr. Arman Zargaran were Chairman, Editor in Chief, and Deputy Editor, respectively. Later, it was changed and Dr. Mehdizadeh and Dr. Zargaran are Chairman and Editor in Chief, respectively since 2019 up to now. (Zargaran, 2019, pp. 1-2) The editorial team of the journal consists of faculties with different related professions including:

Language of the journal

The journal was started to be published as a three lingual journal at first. Authors could publish their papers in English, or Persian or Arabic until end of 2018. But, it makes some difficulties to get more high quality indexings for the journal. Therefore, the policy of journal was changed and the journal was published only in English since 2019 to now. (Mehdizadeh, 2018, pp. 193-194)

Abstracting and indexing of the journal

Abstracting and indexing of the journal is too important to increase the visibility of the published articles. Therefore, journal of research on history of medicine aims to index in high quality abstracting databases. Currently, journal of research on history of medicine is indexed in DOAJ, EBSCO, Index Copernicus, ISC, HI-NARI, SID, Google scholar, Open J-Gate, Geneva Free Medical Journals, Free Medical Journals, EMRmedex, Iran Medex, Magiran and Electronic Journals Library. Also, it is under review by ISI web of Science for indexing in ESCI.

Furthermore, this journal is Scientific-Research rated by the Iranian Medical Journals Commission. Journal of research on history of medicine is published under supervision of UNESCO Chair for the history of traditional medicine.

Authors and articles

There are 284 articles which were published in the journal of research on history of medicine during past 10 years. The detail of these published articles are summarized in Table 1.

There are 174, 96 and 13 papers in English, Persian and Arabic, respectively. In addition, one article was published trilingual (in Persian, English and Arabic). There are 342 authors who contribute to write these 284 papers. Among them, 90 authors have more than one articles and 252 ones have only one article. In Table 2, the authors who contribute to write at least 6 articles in this journal is listed.

Although, A.Zargaran and A.Mehdizadeh have most articles among authors, most of them are editorials, obituary, announcement and report. It is due to their roles as Chairperson or Editor in Chief.

Conclusion

The results show that journal of research on history of medicine succeeds to publish continuously during past 10 years and absorbs international cooperation very well. It is indexed in 14 indexing and abstracting databases. However, it needs to set a program for improving the quality of international cooperation, indexing the journal and published papers for next decade.
